# What is the new gTLD program?

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Generic top-level domains (gTLDs) present unique opportunities for brands, geographic regions, governments and businesses to enhance their presence on the Internet.

For the first time in over a decade, organisations around the world will have the chance to apply for a new gTLD. The "New gTLD Program: Next Round" is aimed at making the Internet more inclusive and more useful to more users.

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# The Applicant Support Program

Applying for a gTLD is expensive (approx. \$227,000 USD) and may be out of reach for many. The Applicant Support Program makes applying for a new gTLD more accessible by providing financial and capacity building support.

Candidates for the applicant support program must be one of the following:

- Nonprofit, nongovernmental, and charitable organizations
- Intergovernmental organizations
- Indigenous/tribal peoples' organizations
- Micro and small businesses that are social enterprises or that operate in a less-developed economy

The Applicant Support Program offers a 75-85% reduction in applicable gTLD evaluation fees, bid credit, reduced/waived base registry operator fees, training and capacity development related to the program.

#### What are TLDs?

Top-level domains form the last part of a domain name, appearing after the dot. For example, in the domain name icann.org, the characters 'org' identify the TLD.



The most common TLDs include .com, .org, .net but you may be surprised to know that there are more than 1200 TLDs.

Other examples of generic TLDs include: .info, .asia, .travel, .new, .biz, .info, .museum...

The potential advantages of owning a gTLD are as follows:

- Registry operators generate revenue through domain name registration fees.
- Businesses can build or extend brands.
- Entrepreneurs can create online markets for products or services.
- Regions and governments can highlight the unique offerings and culture of their regions and promote services to their citizens and visitors.
- Communities and businesses can expand reach through the use of local scripts.
